To present the National Arts Strategy for adoption

Summary

With support from the AONB network, the NAAONB has commissioned and adopted the 'Arts in the Landscape Strategy: connecting people to nature through art and culture'. Each AONB is invited to adopt the Strategy as an indication of the joint commitment to deepen and diversify how we engage people in our protected areas through the arts.

Recommendation

Members are asked to agree that:

1. The AONB Board adopts the Arts in the Landscape Strategy and participates in coordinated national and local action resulting from the Strategy.
2. While there can be no commitment at the moment, the Board would consider a possible future contribution to the collective Arts in Landscape fund, in particular the proposed 5-year national post that will provide a resource to all AONBs.
